## ENGLISH

**The Day the Crayons Quit** - We will be practising our retrieval and inference comprehension skills. We will look at vocabulary choices and make predictions. Our writing will focus on persuasive letters and adventure stories, in response to the text.

**Flat Stanley** - We will be developing our retrieval and inference skills, summarising events and highlighting vocabulary choices. Our writing will focus on recounts and building suspense in stories.



## SCIENCE

## HISTORY AND GEOGRAPHY

In the first half term, we will be exploring the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will study how early man survived. We will also look at the evidence that exists for this era e.g. the remains of Skara Brae.  
After half term, we will be changing to look at why people live near volcanoes in Geography.

- Measurement - length, capacity, time.
- Properties of 2D and 3D shapes
- Position and direction
- Fractions - Recognise, find and write fractions of amounts.
