## ENGLISH

We will spend time revising grammatical terminology and working on new spelling patterns.

We will cover these areas throughout the term:

- \*Understanding and investigating with numbers:
  - \*place value, ordering and rounding
  - \*properties of numbers and number sequences
  - \*fractions, decimals and percentages
- \*developing and applying calculation:
  - \*addition and subtraction
  - \*multiplication and division
- \*Measurement
  - \*properties of shapes
  - \*position and direction

We will also take part in daily mastering number sessions. All of these sessions focus on learning all of our multiplication facts.
