ENGLISH

Fluffy the Killer Cat - We will be practising our inference and summarising comprehension skills. We will look at vocabulary choices and make predictions. Our writing will focus on diary extracts and character descriptions, in response to the text.

Kennings - In this poetry unit, we will learn what a kenning is. We will explore how they are written and explore writing our own kenning poems.



MATHS

We will cover these areas throughout the term:

- Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100
- Represent numbers in different ways.
- Order and compare numbers.
- Place value of 4 digit numbers
- Addition and subtraction using written methods.
- Measurement - length and time.
- Position and direction - recognising turns and compass directions.
- Fractions - finding fractions of amounts, adding, comparing and ordering.
- Multiplication and division - 4 and 8 times tables and multiplying 2 and 3 digit numbers.



SCIENCE

Our topic for this term is:
Plants



HISTORY AND GEOGRAPHY

In the first half term, we will be exploring Ancient Egypt. We will study hieroglyphics, pyramids, mummifications, farming and games.

After half term, we will be changing to look at who lives in Antarctica. We will be learning about how latitude and longitude link to climate and the physical and human features of polar regions.
